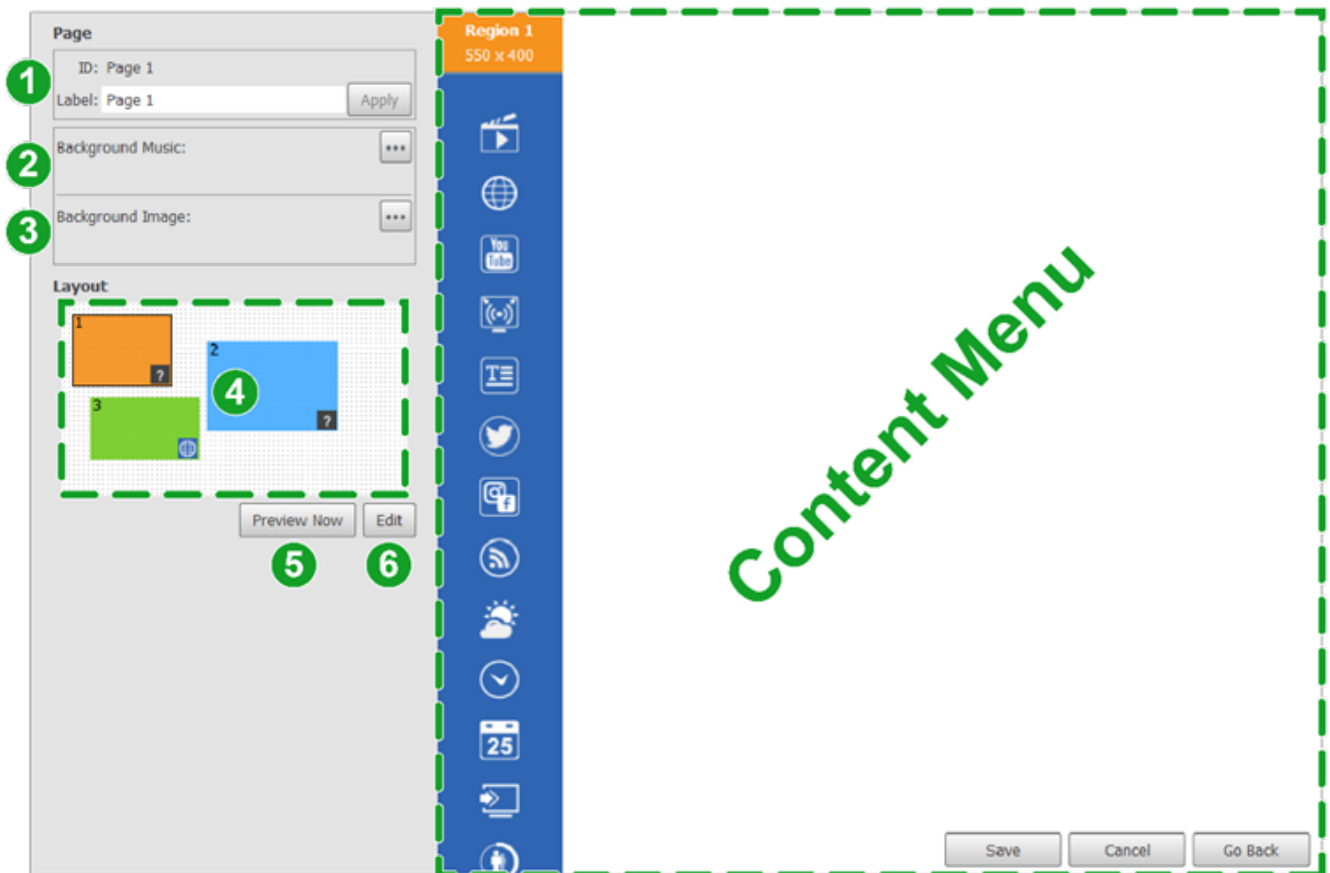




## 2.6.5 The “Editing” Panel

The editing panel is the main interface for editing the content within a playlist page. Follow the steps below to edit the content for a page:



*NOTE: If your playlist contains multiple pages, select the **Pages** in the side panel and select the page you want to edit from the page list.*

1. [OPTIONAL] In the **Label** field, edit the name of the page.
2. [OPTIONAL] In the **Background Music** field, click the more button (  ) to add background music to the page or playlist via a music file stored on your local device or via an audio stream URL.
3. [OPTIONAL] In the **Background Image** field, click the more button (  ) to add a background image or color to the page.

*NOTE: The **Background Image** field adds a background to the respective page only. For instructions on adding a background for the entire playlist, go to *The Background Design Panel*.*

4. In the **Layout** window, click on any of the page items to configure the content for the item in the content menu. Go to *The Content Menu* for more details regarding the content menu.
5. [OPTIONAL] Click **Preview Now** to view a preview of the page.
6. [OPTIONAL] Click **Edit** to change or edit the layout for the page. For layouts that used Grid mode, go to *Using Grid Mode* for more details on editing the layout. For layouts that used Flexible mode, go to *Using Flexible Mode* for more details on editing the layout.
