
2.10 Firmware Update with USB Drive

Important:


- 1. This document is applicable to NovoTouch EK series, including NovoTouch EK-2/EK-3 series.
- Each EK model has its own upgrade package. Please make sure you download the correct package for your model. Using a wrong package could make your NovoTouch unable to boot up.

Step-by-step instructions:

- The upgrade package is stored in a folder called "upgrade_811" / "upgrade_9950". When you receive the firmware upgrade package, typically you need to unzip it first and then copy folder "upgrade_811" / "upgrade_9950" onto a USB disk. You should see the following file/folder structure on the USB disk.
 - For EK2 series, the folder should be "upgrade 811"
 - For EK3 series, the folder should be "upgrade 9950"

- Power downNovoTouch panel.
- Insert the USB
 disk into the USB port at the front panel of NovoTouch
 panel.
- Press-and-hold button POWER until the LED flashes red and blue quickly, indicating the upgrade process is started. Please do NOT remove the USB disk during this process.
- A progress bar is shown to display the completion percentage. Once it gets to 100%, the NovoTouch will restart automatically. During this first-time bootup, it will take a bit

longer to perform some additional post-processing.

• Once it fully boots into Android home screen, the firmware upgrade is completed. Now you can unplug the USB disk.
